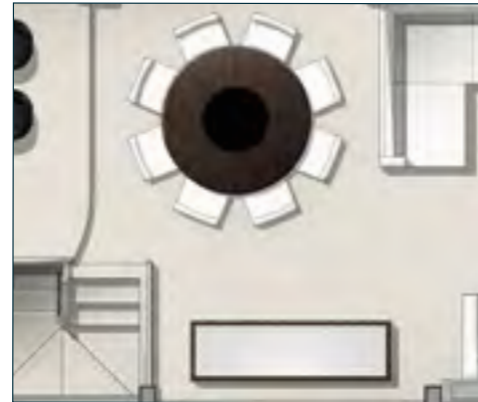


EXTERIOR PLAN
